



Living Bridge

Strong naturalistic theme inspired by pioneer species and flowing, organic forms. Green walls help to provide a sense of a green 'heart' along the bridge

Market Square North / Southern Approach

Strong N/S axis with a focus on species with distinctive autumn colour, creating a strong link between the Market Square and the Living Bridge

Market Square South (not part of Phase 1AN)

Use of productive species as a reference to the agricultural use of this area before extensive development and as a reference to the proposed market emphasis of the Square

Clitterhouse Playing Fields

Strong N/S axis emphasised by tree planting along main pedestrian route



Natural groups of Pine and Birch trees, underplanted by flowing groups of naturalistic grasses and perennials for year round interest

Quercus palustris 40-45cm planted in strong avenues

Semi-mature trees planted in a double avenue

Parkland trees planted in a single avenue
