- Existing fence / property boundary

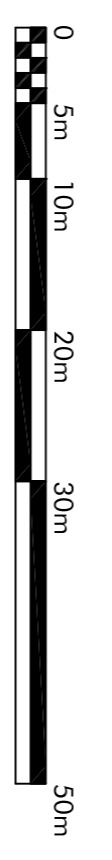

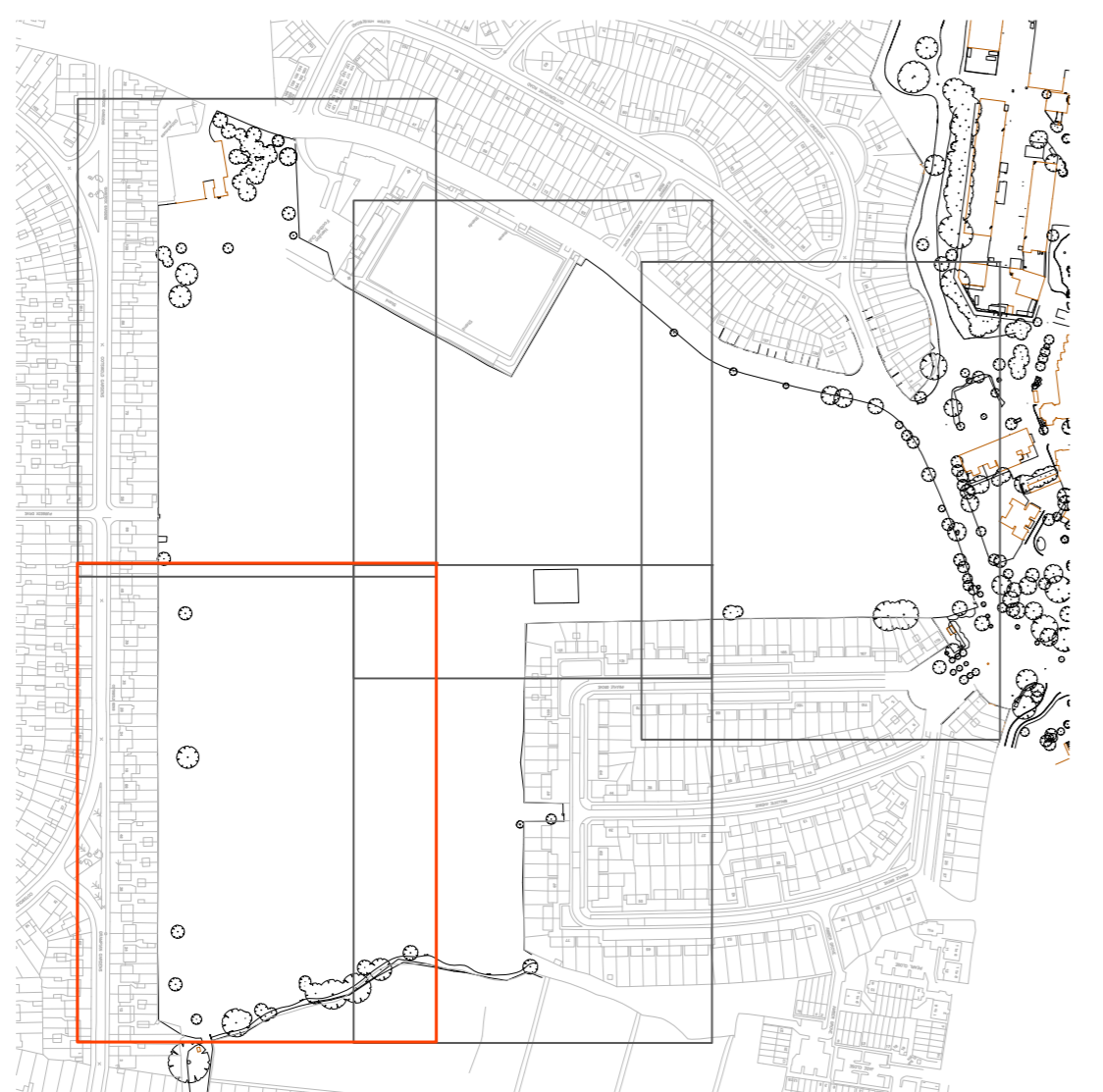
All tree works should adhere to current best practice detailed within BS 5837: 2012 (Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction - recommendations)
