



Summary of Biodiversity elements

1. Re-meander the River Brent and plant within the river channel
2. Creation of wetland habitats within the river corridor
3. Native planting thickening the riparian habitat
4. Limited native tree and scrub planting throughout the Site to widen and strengthen the green corridor
5. Native wildflower grassland creation along the river corridor
6. Bird and bat boxes mounted on or included within the bridges and vertical walls
7. Invasive species – ensure the removal or suitable treatment
