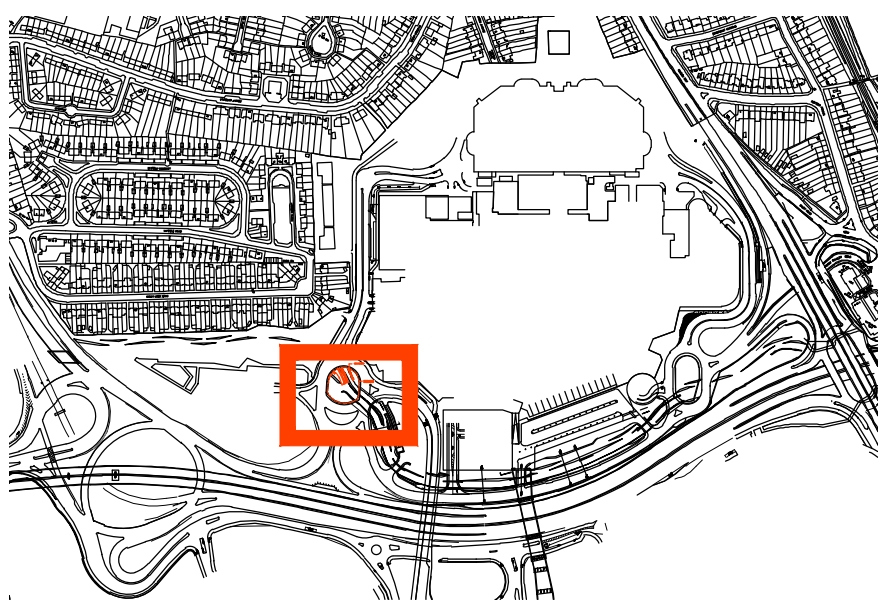
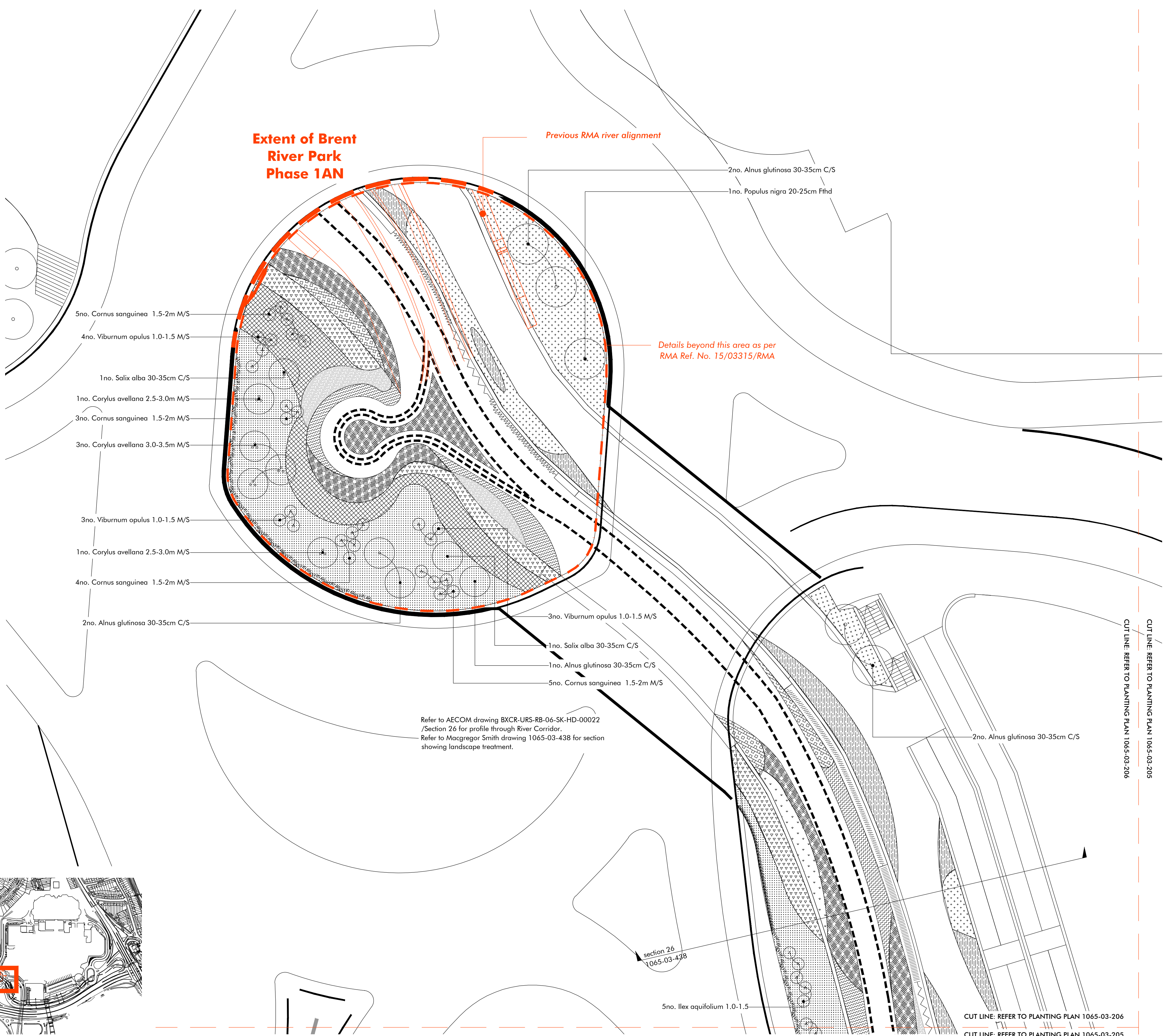

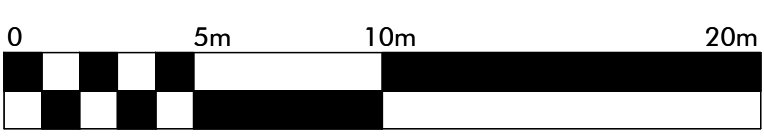


Extent of Brent River Park Phase 1AN
